Deadline for filing for Spring 2008 graduation is Tuesday, May 15, 2007 in order to pay the \$28 fee. A \$10 late fee will be assessed after that date. Students should contact department advisers for a major clearance form early before the rush of finals week and the end of the semester. Applying in the fall semester will delay the receipt of the "grad check" for planning future enrollment.
