<b>4. Eligibility</b>	(a) You must successfully complete at least one semester at CSU, Chico (b) You may apply as a freshman; however, (c) You must have at least 30 units and a 2.5 cum gpa before the exchange begins, (d) <b>PEL and Co-operative education (internships)</b> participants may apply.
<b>5. Ineligible</b>	(a) Academic (b) Administrative (c) Disciplinary Probation or (d) any other category, <b>are not eligible to apply to NSE. By submitting this application, you also give permission to NSE to verify your status at Chico State.</b>
<b>(b) Selection and Ranking process includes</b>	(a) The date the application is received. (b) Your statement, one page only, of why you seek an exchange opportunity. (b) A recommendation from your academic advisor, faculty or a staff member. (c) The nature of your academic record. (d) Your interview <b>(Feb. 24 -26, 2010).</b>
